### **Funding Policy for Competition Season 2015/2016 for Short Track Speed Skating**

#### **World Championships**

SISA will provide support to the top one skater each from Men and Ladies who satisfy the ISU requirements as stipulated in ISU Communications No. 1956 to participate in the World Championships competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy for airfare.

#### **Junior World Championships**

SISA will provide support to the top one skater each from Men and Ladies who satisfy the ISU requirements to participate in the Junior World Championships competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy of SGD800.

Skater(s) in the national / national development team who fulfill the ISU criteria may be considered, subjected to the number of entries submitted for the competition per member country. The said skater(s) will be self-funded for the competition.

#### **World Cup Competitions (Asian sector in Nagoya and Shanghai)**

SISA will provide support to the top three skaters who satisfy the ISU requirements to participate in the above respective World Cup competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy of SGD500 for airfare.

Skater(s) in the national / national development team who fulfill the ISU criteria may be considered, subjected to the number of entries submitted for the competition per member country. The said skater(s) will be self-funded for the competition.



### **World Development Trophy**

SISA will provide support to the top one skater from each age category for Men and Ladies who satisfy the ISU requirements to participate in the World Development Trophy competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy of SGD300 via reimbursement.

Skater(s) in the national / national development team who fulfill the ISU criteria may be considered, subjected to the number of entries submitted for the competition per member country. The said skater(s) will be self-funded for the competition.

### **Asian Trophy**

SISA will provide support to the top one skater from each age category for Men and Ladies who satisfy the ISU requirements to participate in the ASU competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy of SGD300 via reimbursement.

Skater(s) in the national / national development team who fulfill the ISU criteria may be considered, subjected to the number of entries submitted for the competition per member country. The said skater(s) will be self-funded for the competition.

### **SEA Trophy**

SISA will provide support to the top one skater from each age category for Men and Ladies who satisfy the ISU requirements to participate in the SEA competition. SISA will assist in the accommodation and travel arrangements with a basic funding subsidy of SGD100 via reimbursement.

Skater(s) in the national / national development team who fulfill the ISU criteria may be considered, subjected to the number of entries submitted for the competition per member country. The said skater(s) will be self-funded for the competition.

Participation in the above competitions is subjected to the final approval, and at the discretion, of the National Team Coach and SISA Executive Committee.
