**ADDENDUM TO THE
ATHLETES SELECTION POLICY 2018/2019
Short Track Speed Skating**

2019 ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships
Selection of the Men's and Ladies Teams

Reference is made to SISA's Short Track Speed Skating Athlete Selection Policy (2018/2019) which was published on 17 September 2018. Page 8 of the Policy document has been updated as follows:

In an ISU letter dated 20 September 2018, the ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championship will be held between 25 and 27 January 2019 in Montreal, Canada at the Arena Maurice Richard.

(A) Selection Process and Team Composition

1. Reference is made to the ISU Special Regulation & Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating – Rule 283, paragraph 2.
2. Each ISU Member has the right to enter three (3) Competitors in each individual category. ISU Members entering a Relay Team may enter four (4) Competitors in the respective category.
3. A SISA World Junior Selection Trial will be organized after the SEA Trophy 2019 at The Rink @ JCube. A selection trial will not be required and organised if there are less than four (4) ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships' eligible skaters, per gender.
4. Skaters who are age eligible will qualify for the selection trial if they have achieved the qualifying times required for participation in the ISU World Junior Short Track Speed Skating Championships, as announced in [ISU Communication No. 2201](#), in the period from 6 January 2018 to 6 January 2019.
5. Skaters will be seeded based on the times achieved at the SEA Trophy 2019 held on 5 and 6 January 2019 at The Rink @ JCube.



6. The four (4) skaters, per gender, will be selected from the selection trial over 500m and 1000m.
7. Points will be awarded based on the finishing rank of the skaters in the 500m and 1000m race. Points from both distances will be added and the top four (4) ranked skaters by overall classification will be nominated for the Championship.
8. Should there be a tie, the skater with the best 500m timing from the SISA World Junior Selection Trial will be selected.

(B) Final Entry by Name

1. National Coach Chun Lee Kyung will make the selection for the final entry by name from the list of nominated skaters.
2. Not later than one (1) week prior to final entry by name, she will submit all her decisions and supporting reasons to SISA for documentation purpose.
