ADVISORY ON SPORTING EVENTS

1. Please see attached self explanatory circular from Sport Singapore – ‘Advisory for Sporting Fraternity’.
 2. SUSPENSION OF TRAININGS
 - i. As announced yesterday by MOH, "All centre-based tuition and enrichment classes will be suspended. This is to reduce the intermingling of students from different schools and enhance the safety of our students."
 - ii. SISA’s EXCO has deliberated on the matter and as the health and safety of the ice skating community is of utmost importance, a decision has been made to suspend all sporting events which includes training, courses and tests until **4 May 2020**.
 3. We urge all our members to be socially responsible. Let’s not be complacent. Tighter measures in place to reduce risks of new local clusters.
 4. Local cases in SG have risen
 - New clusters in foreign worker dorms, nursing home
 - Despite contact tracing, half of cases unlinked
 5. We need to apply a circuit breaker now for 1 month
 - Reduces risk of big outbreak
 - Bring numbers down
 - Stay at home, as much as possible
 - Avoid socialising beyond immediate family, esp. elderly & vulnerable
 - Go out only for essentials: eg buy food back, exercise at parks at safe distance
