Communication No. 03 **Clarification to Technical Requirements for Basic Novices and below**

Please take note of the following clarifications that are stated in ISU Communication No. 1760 which formed part of the announcement for the 2014 Singapore National Figure Skating Championships & Basic Competitions:

Basic Novice B

Ladies and Men – one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface. The sequence will receive Level features and will also be evaluated in GOE.

Basic Novice A

Men – Maximum 1 step sequence without level value. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Ladies – One choreographic sequence which includes at least one (1) spiral position at least (3) seconds long. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Elementary

Men – Maximum 1 step sequence without level value. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Ladies – One choreographic sequence which includes at least one (1) spiral position at least (3) seconds long. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Preliminary

Men – Maximum 1 step sequence without level value. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Ladies – One choreographic sequence which includes at least one (1) spiral position at least (3) seconds long. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
