SISA ICE TIME
Music Order Draw leading up to 2022 Nationals

Dear Figure Skating Community

With the 2022 Singapore National Figure Skating Championship approaching, the SISA Ice time music order will be conducted in the following manner from 12 February 2022 until the commencement of the Nationals:

1. Music draw will commence on Saturday, 12 February 2022.
2. Bluetooth via your Coach's device.
- 3. Music must be stored and played via your respective Coach's device so as to save time from connecting several devices.**
4. Only self-practice skaters may use your own devices.
5. We urge all skaters and coaches to be aware of your skating order to minimize any wastage of time. The skating order will be available by the rink side.
6. Draw will be done by the SISA staff before sending the attendance sheets to the monitors. Names will be sorted in alphabetical order using the family name before executing the draw.
- 7. Skaters who do not book online (12 hours before the session), will not be included in the draw, and will be placed at the bottom of the drawn list. There will be NO re-draw.**
8. There will be a **5 mins warm up prior** to the start of the first program.
9. Skaters who are not ready for your turn will be regarded as forfeiting your slot. Your next opportunity would only be after the completion of the drawn list, if time permits.
10. Skaters with 2 programs may have the opportunity to conduct their 2nd program after everyone has a turn, if time permits.
11. Mathematically, an hour of ice only permits 17 programs (based on 3 mins per skater). If you are keen to book ice without the running of program, you may still book the ice.
12. If any skaters have / will be booking ice but do not require music playing, it would be helpful to inform us **via your Coach** so that we do not have to include your name onto the draw.

Thank you so much for your cooperation and we wish everyone all the best in their training towards the competition.
