Conditions for valid qualifying times (Junior WC)

- 1. The result must have been achieved at the latest fourteen (14) days before the respective ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Speed Skating in one of the following Competitions:
 - ISU Championships
 - ISU World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competitions
 - ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competitions
 - International Short Track Speed Skating Competitions as listed in the annual ISU Communication published by the ISU
 - National Championships sanctioned by the ISU Member concerned
 - Other Short Track Speed Skating Competitions provided that the conditions c) to f) below are fulfilled
- 2. The Competition must have been held on an official ISU track as defined in Rule 280, paragraph 1.
- 3. Photo finish and/or electronic timing must have been used, proved by original outputs of the equipment. If no Photo finish and/or electronic timing are available 0,2 seconds must be added to the time skated.
- 4. A Referee and Starter, listed under item 2 of ISU Communication No. 2643 must have been officiating.
- 5. A Protocol and a Program of the competition must be available.
- 6. For a Skater to be qualified for participation in the ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Speed Skating 2024/25, only results achieved after July 1, 2022, will be considered.

Conditions for valid qualifying times (World Tour)

- 1. The result must have been achieved and submitted with the Final Entry, ten (10) days before the respective ISU Short Track World Tour in one of the following Competitions:
 - ISU Championships
 - ISU World Cup Short Track Competitions/Short Track World Tour Competitions
 - ISU Junior World Cup Short Track Competitions
 - International Short Track Competitions as listed in the annual ISU Communication published by the ISU
 - National Championships sanctioned by the ISU Member concerned
 - Other Short Track Competitions sanctioned by the ISU
- 2. The Competition must have been held on an official ISU track as defined in Rule 280, paragraph 1.
- 3. Photo finish and/or electronic timing must have been used, proved by original outputs of the equipment. If no Photo finish and/or electronic timing are available 0,2 seconds must be added to the time skated.
- 4. A Referee and Starter, listed under item 2 of ISU Communication No. 2643 must have been officiating.
- 5. A Protocol and a Program of the competition must be available.
- 6. For a Skater to be qualified for participation in the ISU Short Track World Tour 2024/25, only results achieved after July 1, 2022, will be considered.



Conditions for valid qualifying times (World Champs, Junior Champs & 4CC)

- 7. The result must have been achieved at the latest fourteen (14) days before the respective ISU Championships in one of the following Competitions:
 - ISU Championships
 - ISU Short Track World Tour / World Cup Competitions
 - International Short Track Speed Skating Competitions 2024/25 as listed in the annual ISU Communication
 - National Championships sanctioned by the ISU Member concerned
 - Other Short Track Speed Skating Competitions sanctioned by the ISU.
- 1. The Competition must have been held on an official ISU track as listed in Rule 280, paragraph 1.
- 2. Photo finish and/or electronic timing must have been used, proved by original outputs of the respective equipment. If no Photo finish and/or electronic timing are available 0,2 seconds must be added to the time recorded.
- 3. A Referee and Starter, listed under item 2 of ISU Communication No. 2643 must have been officiating.
- 4. The distances skated, and the starting times must have been in accordance with the announcement.
- 5. A Protocol and a Program of the competition must be available.
- 6. Results achieved after July 1, 2022, may be considered.
- 7. ISU Members entering participants must submit verification of the qualifying times achieved by each Competitor. This documentation must be submitted to the ISU Secretariat at the latest on the 10th day before the start of the first race of the Competition (Rule 292, paragraph 1.c). The respective Representative of the Technical Committee for the Championships will review the documents and confirm whether the qualifying criteria have been respected and if the entry can be accepted.
