

Addendum to "33rd SOUTHEAST ASIAN (SEA) GAMES ATHLETES' SELECTION POLICY (Figure Skating)"

This addendum is made on 13 August 2025, to the Selection Policy for the 33rd Southeast Asian (SEA) Games, approved by the Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOC), dated 14 August 2025.

On 6 August 2025, the Singapore Ice Skating Association (SISA) received the updated Technical Handbook (THB) from the SNOC. The THB reflects that the age requirement has been updated.

The purpose of this addendum is to update the following clauses:

Clause			
1.3	 (a) Figure Skating – Singles Women and Men Skaters will compete according to their respective age categories (Senior / Junior) and will be judged within their own category – Senior or Junior – based on the ISU Technical Rules. However, for the purpose of final results, all skaters will be combined into a single Open Category. 		
	iii. The overall ranking will be determined by the total scores of each skater, regardless of category.		
	 iv. Medals will be awarded to the top three skaters in the Open Category. 		
1.6	Qualification Period – 6 February 2025 to 24 August 2025		
	* Due to the new addition of Junior events which were not present during the 2019 SEA Games, SISA has used the 2019 SEA Games bronze medallist result (Senior category) deducting the technical differences between the two categories to derive a Junior equivalent.		
2.1 (a)	be a citizen of the Republic of Singapore (in accordance with ISU Communication <u>2526</u>);		
2.1 (f)	meet the <u>minimum</u> age eligibility requirements prescribed by the Games Organizer and SNOC, <u>namely</u> :		
2.1 (f)(i – iii)	(i) be at least fifteen (15) years of age (before 1 July 2025); and		
	(ii) for Senior categories – have reached at least the age of seventeen (17) before 1 July 2025; or		
	(iii) for Junior categories – have reached at least the age of fifteen (15) and has not reached the age of nineteen (19) before 1 July 2025 and

3.2 (b)	Should any nominated athlete be unable to compete at the 33rd SEA Games by reason of injury, illness or unforeseen reasons <u>prior to departure</u> , then the SISA Selection Panel may nominate a replacement Athlete for nomination to the SNOC from the reserve list.			
3.2 (c)	For athlete replacements after the Entry By Name deadline, only athletes previously selected by SNOC selection or appeal committees can be considered as replacement athletes. Any replacements are subject to the conditions of late athlete replacement set by the event organiser.			
4.1	Should any nominated athlete be unable to compete in the Southeast Asian Games 2025 for any reason then SISA may identify a replacement Athlete for nomination to the SNOC in accordance with Section 3 of this Nomination Criteria prior to departure.			
4.2 (a)(iii)	For athlete replacements after the Entry By Name deadline, only athletes previously selected by SNOC selection or appeal committees can be considered as replacement athletes. Any replacements are subject to the conditions of late athlete replacement set by the event organiser.			
5.2	Entries by name for the 33rd SEA Games will be submitted no later than 31 August 2025 or by the Appeals Deadline stipulated by SNOC. Nominations made after this deadline (or within such further deadline as the SNOC may allow) will be invalid.			
7.3	Athletes must state in writing via email on their intention to appeal a selection decision by 23 August 2025, 23:59, after the SISA's announcement of Athlete Nominations for the SEA Games 2025,
